1. **Welcome, Housekeeping & Apologies**

Apologies were noted and Samantha welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. **Declarations of Interest**

None to declare.

3. **Operations Update (Anna)**

Project A-Void – Cornwall Council gave permission to install two additional heritage photos on electrical boxes (opposite Roskear School and near Camborne Library). The planning application for the wayfinding signage recently went to Camborne Town Council and a vote was made to refuse it. Anna asked directors how BID should approach the next step? It was suggested getting detailed feedback as to why a, b, c etc was turned down and ask for a meeting for clarification.

Action: Anna will send a letter to individual members of the planning committee as well as the committee itself.

Anna confirmed Camborne Town Council have recently secured funding from Devon and Cornwall Police regarding graffiti in town. Anna has tried to gather more information from Hayley (CTC) about the project. Samantha suggested popping in to see Hayley at the office.

Camborne Renew – Cosmic will provide some concept designs for the New Connexion Street mural. Businesses and landlords will also see the vision board following the sessions with local schools and organisations. There are still a few sessions left to confirm with Kehelland Trust, Disability Cornwall and Camborne Youth Club. Anna asked if a general session for the community and businesses would be beneficial? **Action: Anna will book an evening session at Tyacks and will send the mood board to directors.**

The meeting inviting members of the community to view the amended designs has been rearranged from September to October. The Renew team are keen to make sure the works don't start when it will be an inconvenience for businesses. Anna has looked ahead and made sure to give the team dimensions and confirm access needed for Christmas. Samantha thanked Anna for all her hard work. **Action: Anna will contact the Camborne Renew team as the new consultation date has not been publicised.**

BID:BIS Scheme (DISC) – The piloting period for DISC has nearly ended. Anna recently attended a very positive meeting with Alison Hernandez who confirmed her next project will be focused on Camborne. **Action: Anna will write to IPCC to ask for some funding towards DISC and graffiti.**

With the piloting period ending, directors were asked to discuss management of the system and the different payment options. A quote from Littoralis and DaytoDay Admin Services has been received to administer the system. And three different payment options were discussed for the on-going use of DISC.

Decisions regarding DISC administration and payment options

Ian proposed payment Option 3 and this was seconded by Jo. All in favour.

Samantha proposed using DaytoDay Admin Services and this was seconded by Jo. All in favour.

Fun Fridays – The programme of events were well received, and no one noticed the shorter timetable.

4. **Minutes of the Board – 14th 2025**

Minutes were proposed by Samantha and seconded by Brian. All in favour.

5. **Minutes of Xmas WG – 11th August 2025**

Minutes were proposed by Jo and seconded by Samantha. All in favour.

Rental period regarding the lights from L&T were discussed.

All agreed to go with the 3-year rental period. Proposed by Ian and seconded by Brian. All in favour.

6. **Financial Update**

Currently in a healthy position for this time of year. Project Avoid money is ring-fenced for the wayfinding signage. Anna will liaise with Cornwall Council regarding the remaining aging debtors.

7. **AOB**

Brian mentioned Camborne Market are looking for someone to manage it as a few people will be retiring soon and it could close if support is not found.

Camborne Town Council will have the lantern parade on 27th November and they have asked if BID would like a stall. **Action: Anna will see Alicia about a stall.**

The Camborne Yarn Bombers will install some vibrant knitted goods which will be displayed around the town to celebrate Fairtrade Fortnight. Alicia at Camborne Town Council said she will produce a map and Steve will take some photos of the installations. The next meeting for the Camborne Yarn Bombers is 16th September and Brian said he would like to attend. Anna will speak to Sue Bradbury about a press release and the installations will be put up around the town on Sunday 21st September.
